- auchrannie welcome all well behaved dogs for just a small charge
- so we don't make any mess, dogs are not allowed in the reception area or any other public area in the hotel and are only allowed in the bedrooms
- we must not be left alone in the bedroom unless the pack leaders are dining on site or we have a dog cage, and we are not allowed to jump on the bed or soft furnishings
- remind your pack leader not to forget your dog bedding and feeding bowls
- your room will be cleaned between the hours of 11.00am and 2.00pm at this time you must be out of the room to allow housekeepers to enter
- big fluffy drying towels are placed at the end of the ground floor corridor, this is a special VIP doggy entrance/exit where we must come in and out of the building, after our long walks in the glen
- we need to be dried and our paws wiped before going along the corridors and our dirty dog towels should be put in the bin provided
- we must not be noisy and disturb other guests or we will be asked to leave the building
- we have to be fully inoculated and have had veterinary health checks
- pack leaders are fully responsible for our behaviour at all times whilst on site and put us on a lead when near others, and if we are really naughty they will be liable for all costs incurred for repair or replacement.
- pack leaders must clean up after us, bins are provided at both Hotel and Spa Resort for depositing our messes and special bags can be bought at the Spa Shop
